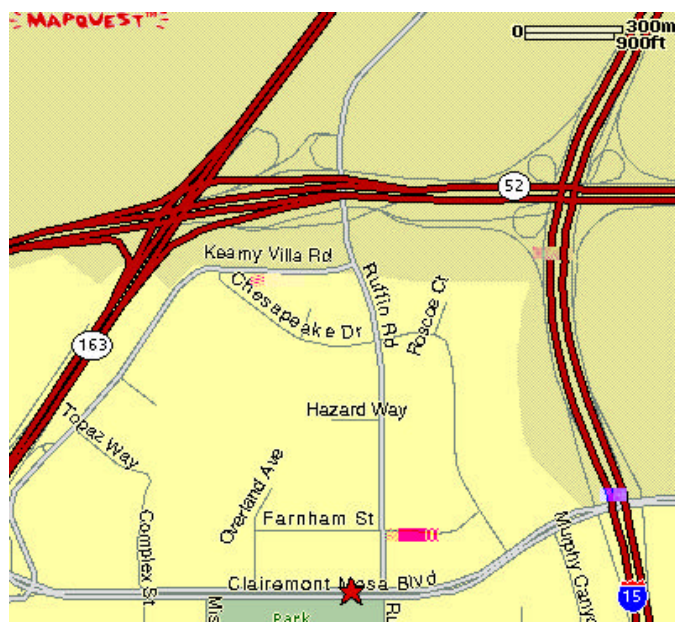

**The History of Cathodic Protection -
 A Materials Perspective**

President, Bencor Corrosion Specialists

From the Stone Age, Bronze Age, and Iron Age, the progress of mankind has been described by the advancement of materials. Advancements in materials science have greatly affected the way we live and work. In the field of cathodic protection, a method of corrosion control using electrochemistry, conductive ceramics are just one example where modern materials have made new things possible. Roger will provide a historical perspective about the material advancements associated with the interesting field of cathodic protection design and installation.

Biography

Roger Benham has extensive experience in cathodic protection design and chemical water treatment systems. He received a BS in Metallurgical Engineering from Cal Poly, worked as a metallurgist at General Atomics, and designed cathodic protection systems at a corrosion engineering company prior to starting his own company, Bencor Corrosion Specialists. He is a member of the American Chemical Society, NACE International, ASM International. Roger recently lectured at the chapter's Spring Education Series on Corrosion and is a past-chair of the chapter.
